STORY TIMES THIS MONTH!**



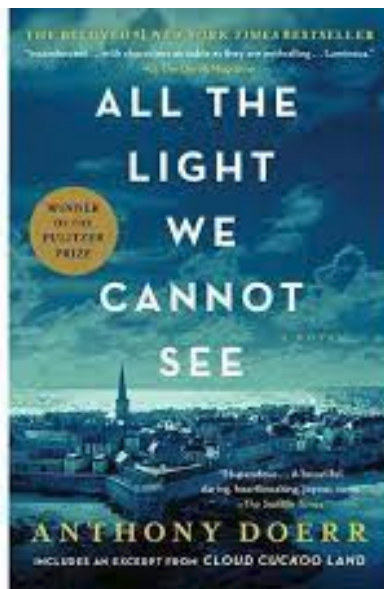

For those of you who enjoy reading eBooks and/or listening to eAudiobooks, there are some changes on the horizon! The Vermont Department of Libraries recently announced that they are contracting with a company called LYRASIS, in order to expand digital offerings. All patrons will be able to use their Palace app, and as the press release says, it “aggregates eBook and eAudiobook content from multiple vendors into a single interface, increasing access, ease of use, and appeal.” In other words, LYRASIS will be providing many more options for your e-content enjoyment.
