ARPA GRANT NEWS


The Haston has received Round Two of the American Rescue Plan Act grants for libraries. Round One was in the amount of approximately \$2,100, and Round Two is in the neighborhood of \$700. So far, we've gotten a couple of canopies for outdoor programming, plus folding chairs and a table that can be used outdoors as well. We've also gotten some fun things for the kids, like a marble run that's proving to be pretty popular! Two Little Free Libraries are on the way; one will be installed at the State Park, and we're hoping to place the other one in a central location in the village. The grant money has also allowed us to order two new computers, and we will be adding more books to the collection as well.
